Highway A75 : exits are Massiac (120 km from Maurs) and Saint Flour (110 km)

Highway A20 : exit Montfaucon (65 km from Maurs)

Accommodation in a tent and the stall for the horse are included in the package for 1, 2 and 3 October.

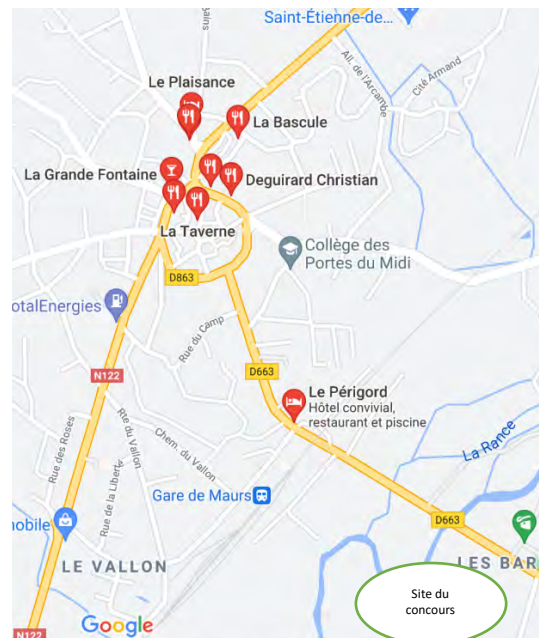
Where to eat ?
